

RESEARCH EXPERIENCE FOR TEACHERS ADVANCEMENT IN NANOTECHNOLOGY



Funded by the National Science Foundation, the Research Experiences for Teacher Advancement In Nanotechnology (RETAIN) is a six week (June 15 - July 25, 2025) program that provides a unique opportunity for high-school teachers and 2-year college instructors to explore the interdisciplinary field of nanotechnology at IU Indianapolis and its impact on STEM education.

About the Program

- The program is for US citizens or permanent residents only.
- Teachers can receive up to \$8,000 via stipend, tuition, supplies, and travel.
 - The program pays a stipend of \$6,000.
 - Travel reimbursements of up to \$1,000 will be covered to attend and present at a national conference.
 - Up to \$1,000 to purchase materials/supplies to assist teachers in transferring the research experience to their classrooms.
- Participants are required to attend the entire six weeks research activity including all weekly meetings, seminars, field trips, and workshops.
